Home Cooking Skills

Giving young people the basic skills and knowledge to cook for themselves in a healthy way.

Learning Support Sessions

Pupils with additional needs can be timetabled sessions where they can receive additional support with homework, classwork, study skills and revision.



Alternative Curriculums

In year 10 every pupil is encouraged to undertake a full GCSE curriculum; there are also alternative qualifications available. Learning support sessions can be added to timetables so pupils can receive guidance with work.

Public Services BTEC first Award

Public Services BTEC first Award is a combination of an exam, practical experience and written assignments, these vocational qualifications provide level 1/2 learners with the knowledge, skills and understanding needed for a career in the Public Service sector.

- Central Government
- Local Authorities
- Voluntary services

Functional Skills and Entry Level Qualifications
