



GROUP SUPPORT

Given either in class or out, supported by LA, under direct supervision of the class teacher:

e.g. setting specific tasks - under the supervision of LAs, for the group to bring back to the whole class later in the lesson.

INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT

Enabling a pupil's access to class learning along with their peers.

Differentiation of work tailored to suit pupil's individual learning styles.



PRACTICAL SUPPORT

Help with handling equipment, reading scales/measurements etc.

CLASSROOM SUPPORT

Quality First Universal Teaching

Enabling the pupil to become an independent learner.

ADDITIONAL LEARNING SUPPORT

Provided outside of the lesson, either subject specific or general, to enable pupils to catch up or to reinforce learning in the classroom.
