



Nurture Group

We hold a nurture group in the Scholastica rooms at break and lunchtime. This group aims to give encouragement to pupils who require a little extra support with the social and emotional aspects of school life.

The pupils can enjoy their snacks/lunch at a dinner table where discussion is encouraged. Afterwards the group members join together to participate in cooking, gardening, crafts and other group activities.

Social and Emotional Support.

One to one sessions and friendship groups are used to support pupils emotionally and socially.

For some pupils, limiting the number of learning assistants supporting them is appropriate as is the identification of a key LA.



Higher Level Interventions.

Some pupils will require additional support with Literacy and Numeracy; this is offered within our learning centre. Pupils can learn at their own pace, concentrating on their specific area of difficulty. Teaching methods ensure a multi – sensory approach to learning is used.

Interventions/support.

Reading Challenge



The reading challenge is an identified targeted program of support for pupils with a significant gap in their reading level.

Parents are encouraged to listen to their child read daily alongside them having daily reading sessions in school.

Sixth Form Support.

Within our sixth form some pupils still require additional support with organisation, planning and also social/emotional support.

Pupils can arrange to meet learning assistants who can support them within these areas, again encouraging independence of learning.

Classroom support

Learning assistants work within some classrooms supporting Quality First universal teaching. Concentrating upon developing pupils ability to learn and work independently thus preparing them for adult life. This may include differentiation of work, explanation and consolidation, different approaches to learning and different methods of recording.
