



### BTEC Level 1 & 2

#### Home Cooking Skills

Giving young people the basic skills and knowledge to cook for themselves.

- Continue cooking for themselves and their families
- Transferring the skills they acquire to other recipes
- Inspiring others by passing on their knowledge.

### Learning Support Sessions

Pupils with additional needs can be timetabled sessions where they can receive additional support with homework, classwork, study skills and revision.



### IT & Enterprise

Students will follow an OCR National Certificate at either level 1 or 2. There are three units:

1. Introduction to Business—I hour written exam
2. Planning for work—Controlled Assessment
3. Setting up and running an enterprise—Controlled Assessment

## Alternative Curriculums

In year 10 every pupil is encouraged to undertake a full GCSE curriculum; however, this can be supported through support sessions and alternative qualifications.

Each year the school look at the cohort and explore relevant qualifications.



### Additional English and Maths

For those students who would benefit from additional teaching in English and Maths that are working below a level 4.

These students may work towards the Functional Skills exams alongside revisiting key mathematical and literacy skills.



### Functional Skills Qualifications

In Maths and English functional skills qualifications can be taken alongside GCSEs:

- Providing student with an additional qualification or providing a student with an achievable qualification.
